**Assessment:**

1. Another busy early afternoon session across The Paddocks where something positive needs to be done to address some more of the outbound speeding by cars to complement the efforts being made by CRW in writing to the companies of commercial vehicles\* found to be travelling at excessive/unacceptable speeds  
(\*where appropriate executive contact email details can be found in the public domain).

**Recommendation To Council:**

1. Support CRW's efforts to make Hilton a safer place for all road users in the absence of any other kerbside activity.  
2. Start up Speedwatch to complement CRW's efforts.  
3. Consider requesting CRW to locate a SID on the telegraph pole at the Paddocks.  
4. Consider supporting CRW with a donation of £50 for the services rendered in the first 6 months of 2018 (attached).
