Assessment:

1. A concerning level of speeding continues to threaten the safety of residents at this end of the village where outbound vehicles start their acceleration run once past the Graveley Way junction and see trees thus believing the end of the village has been reached or that there are no hazards ahead and no signs to contradict that impression.
2. Mick George vehicles at 20 mph do help to moderate some speeding.
3. Letters have been sent to appropriate executives of those companies whose light vehicles were detected speeding at 35 mph or more or 34 mph for HGVs.
4. The Heartland Interiors vehicle without an MoT was reported to the Police via their web portal where it is now not possible, despite it inviting submissions, to report any speeding vehicles for the purpose of any action being taken by anyone.

Recommendation To Council:

1. Consider installing 'Pedestrians in Road' signs to alert drivers about the crossing point right on that Paddocks bend.
2. Consider supporting Community Roadwatch and asking them to install one of their SIDs on the telegraph post at the Paddocks to see if that makes a difference prior to funding a permanent solar-powered installation there like they have in Hemingford Abbots.
