Assessment:

1. Another typical session at the Paddocks with serious speeding detected.
2. Also during the session the Team were buzzed by a grey BMW BJ04 BZA that was later found to be SORN's off the road and untaxed but then reported to the Police via it's web portal the response basically was 'call us at the time or don't call us at all' - So, no further action to be taken and an uninsured driver is free to frequent our roads with apparent impunity or anyone worrying about it.

Recommendation To Council:

1. Consider the placement of 'Pedestrian in Road' signs to warn drivers about the crossing at the Paddocks.
2. Consider asking CRW to loan a SID for placement at the Paddocks to see if speeding can be moderated there using such a device.
